Safety First!

The Inferno has dramatically lowered step heights. Depending upon front axle and tires, your step height is as low as 19"! The lower step is oversized, with a polished open-grip finish for sure footing. Each door opening has an intermediate step for easy entry and egress.



Smart Wheel Steering

Keep the driver's hands where they belong: on the steering wheel! The Ferrara *Smart Wheel* allows the driver to control headlights, wipers, turn signals, auxiliary engine braking system, electronic siren, mechanical siren, automotive horn and air horns without taking their hands off the wheel.



Our large front and side grills circulate the air in the engine tunnel so you don't have heat build up inside the cab. That makes our already powerful air conditioning system's performance that much more impressive.



Unmatched Visibility

Only Ferrara gives you a windshield with over 4,200 square inches of viewing area plus oversized side windows for great visibility. Our 43 degrees of viewing at the windshield leads the industry.



Easy Service and Rugged Construction

When we designed the Inferno, we set out to create a true, extreme duty fire chassis. Dash and instrument panels, overhead console, glove box and door panels are all made from rugged welded aluminum. We use texture paint that's easy to maintain and easy to touch up.



When you need to service gauges, 4 quarter turn screws open up the easy-access hinged panel. The chassis electrical panel is at the center of the dash under a large hinged panel. Common sense design, built to last a lifetime. It's what you've come to expect from Ferrara.

Complete Airbag Protection

Because everyone in the cab should be protected! Ferrara's CAP system provides three layers of protection in the event of vehicle rollover: suspension seats are all drawn down to the lowest level; seat belts are retracted to keep occupants in place; and airbags inflate at all perimeter seating positions.
